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1. Aims

This policy aims to ensure that:

Suitable education is arranged for pupils on roll who cannot attend school due to health needs

Pupils, staff and parents understand what the school is responsible for when education is being provided by the local authority

2. Legislation and guidance

This policy reflects the requirements of the Education Act 1996.

This policy complies with our funding agreement and articles of association.

3. The responsibilities of the school

3.1 If the school decides

The school will attempt to deliver suitable education for children with health needs who cannot attend school.

The class teacher will be responsible for making and monitoring these arrangements.

Work will be provided on our school website and resources, where necessary, will be sent home.

Class teachers will communicate directly with parents to inform them of how they can support remotely.

In consultation with parents, a reintegration plan will be devised by the class teacher, SLT and parents/carers.

3.2 If the local authority decides

If the school cannot make suitable arrangements, Bucks County Council will become responsible for arranging educational provision for the child. In cases where the local authority makes arrangements, the school will:

- integrated back into school successfully

When reintegration is anticipated, the school will work with the local authority to:

- Plan for consistent provision during and after the period of education outside the school, allowing the pupil access to the same curriculum and materials that they would have used in school as far as possible
- Enable the pupil to stay in touch with school life (e.g. through newsletters, emails, invitations to school events or internet links to lessons from their school)
- Create individually tailored reintegration plans for each child returning to school
- Consider whether any reasonable adjustments need to be made

4. Monitoring arrangements

This policy will be reviewed annually by Louise White Headteacher.
